The event took place in Florencio Varela (Argentina) on Sunday, September 8.

She wears our Fontaine wigs not only at her concerts but on various other occasions as well, including theater, dramas, and radio shows open to the public.

In August 2024, Saeki was appointed as "Académica Correspondiente" (Correspondence Academician) of La Academia Nacional del Tango de la República Argentina (the National Academy of Tango of the Argentine Republic), being recognized for her achievements as a tango singer over the years in the tango community. She performs in numerous events and on media also in Argentina, the birthplace of Tango. At the Varela Matsuri this year, Saeki performed as the representative of Japanese tango singers, wearing Fontaine's original wigs tailored to her stage and image. During the concert, she sang Japan's famous songs as well as her original pieces. She also performed a duet with a folklore singer Bruno Arias, singing a masterpiece of Argentinian music "Sólo Le Pido A Dios" (I only ask of God) and her original song "Yo Vengo A Ofrecer Mi Corazón" (I will give my heart to you) together.

We will also support Saeki at a quartet concert with young musicians, to be held on Friday, November 22. Fontaine was launched as the fashion wig brand to help women keep shining. Through this brand, we are committed to supporting Saeki, who actively serves as a bridge between Japan and Argentina.

Born in Asahikawa, Hokkaido, Saeki currently serves as Asahikawa Tourism Ambassador. She made her debut in 1987 as a tango singer after being crowned Miss Sapporo, and has performed in 14 different countries including Carnegie Hall in New York City, the U.S., and the Theatre des Champs-Elysees in Paris, France. Saeki has been chosen as one of the "100 Japanese People Respected in the World" (in "Newsweek Japan") and the "20 people who contributed to Tango" in Argentina. For the celebration of the Argentine bicentennial, she was invited as the first-ever Japanese artist to perform at El Salón Dorado (the Golden Room) in Buenos Aires. In August 2024, Saeki was appointed as "Académica Correspondiente" of La Academia Nacional del Tango de la República Argentina.
